Q&A with Payne Interiors & Design

Q: Where do you find those creative sparks that ignite your design ideas?

A: I love creating spaces that are functional and beautiful, so one of my favorite parts of designing is getting to be creative in coming up with solutions to a problem through design and then going that extra step and making it really beautiful to fit the client's space.



Q: Trends come and go, but a well-designed space is timeless. How would you incorporate trends while ensuring a design stays relevant for years to come?

A: Everyone loves a good trend, and sometimes there is a functional reason why a trend is popular such as the conversation pit from the 60s, but as a designer I think it's really key to incorporate trends in a way that blend seamlessly into the overall design and function so that they stand the test of time. So while I like to incorporate some trends to fit the current market, I don't make it the focal point in a design so that it's not outdated in 5 years.

Q: Looking ahead, what exciting design trends or innovations are you keeping an eye on?

A: I have always loved more unique, antique pieces and rich color schemes, and I really think those are making a comeback. I think everyone is tired (thank goodness) of the same old boring grey and white. We're moving away from the cookie cutter clean, white kitchens look and more towards rich mono colored rooms dripped in shades of the same color all the way to the molding/trim and really integrating beautiful antique statement pieces and naturally striking elements such as honed marble and warm wood beams.

Q: Budget is always a concern. What are your top tips for homeowners who want a designer touch but might be on a tight budget?

A: Don't be scared to hire a designer. While I know most people are under the assumption that a designer is an extra expense, I can promise you we're not. As designers we get a decent discount on furnishings and trades, we can easily redesign a space that you'll love and designers like myself know how to work with a smaller budget. That being said, you just have to do some research and find budget friendly designers. But a good designer can make sure that you get the designer look for the same price if not cheaper than what you're likely expecting to spend.
